Dear Parents/Guardians,

The teachers will have forms for you to fill in when you attend these meetings and we will be explaining school procedures.

Kindly note that if you need to speak to the teachers or one of the SLT members call on 21317505 to make an appointment and we will be more than happy to meet you. Do not come to school without an appointment and expect to be seen straightaway.

Make sure that all books are covered in plastic and labelled. Kindly take care of all books. If during the scholastic year you wish to transfer your child to another school, the books need to be returned. If a student is going abroad to continue his/her studies, we need a letter stating such event and signed by both parents/guardians. I cannot give permission to students who go on holiday during school days. Travelling abroad for family reasons are tied only to medical reasons, funerals, weddings and anniversaries against which I need proof by documentation.

Make sure you have your child's medical certificate record card when you go to the doctor so that it is signed by doctor and brought to school with a certificate. No certificate can be accepted without the Medical Certificate Record Card (MCRC).

I would like to remind you that when a child has a birthday **NO BIRTHDAY CAKES ALLOWED**. Only plain muffins are allowed. No fillings, no toppings, no cream, no frosting. Any items not following these rules will be sent back home untouched.
